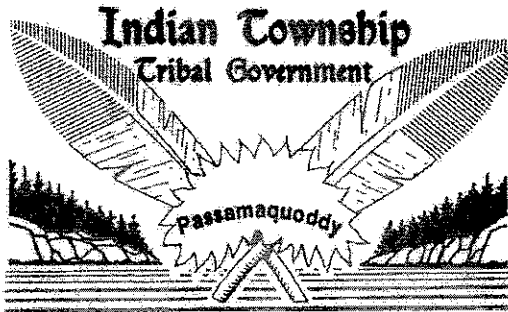



Therefore Be It Resolved: That the Tribal Council affirms it's support of the Project and grants the Indian Township Tribal Governor authority to sign the Maine/Wabanaki Declaration of Intent as presented to the Tribal Government.


