WHEREAS, the Penobscot Indian Nation is a federally recognized sovereign Indian tribe with its seat of government located at Indian Island, Penobscot County, Maine (the "Nation"); and

WHEREAS, the Nation's Chief and Council are the duly authorized and elected governing body of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Penobscot Indian Nation declares that the Truth and Reconciliation Process between Wabanaki Tribes and the state of Maine is important for the well being of our people and community; now

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

The Penobscot Nation Tribal Council reaffirms its full support of the Truth and Reconciliation Process between Wabanaki tribes and the state of Maine and authorizes the Penobscot Nation's Chief to sign the Maine/Wabanaki Declaration of Intent to create a Truth and Reconciliation Process.
